Tiny Black and Yellow Striped Caterpillar

Tiny Black and Yellow Striped Beetle	Small (2–5 mm), black with yellow stripes, hard shell, some with wings	Crawls slowly, attracted to light	Lo w, Kitchen, windowsills, potted plants	Vacuum, wipe surfaces, seal cracks	Spray peppermint oil near windows, wipe surfaces weekly

Tiny Black and Yellow Striped Caterpillar	Soft body, fuzzy, yellow and black stripes	Feeds on leaves	Non寄生的	Indoor plants, balcony	Remove manually, check plants weekly	Place a jar over caterpillars and relocate outside, use neem oil on plants
Tiny Black and white Striped Striped Bug	Black and white stripes, 1-4 mm	Crawls fast, hides in dark areas	Low寄生的	Corners, baseboards	Vacuum, clean corners, seal entry points	Sprinkle diatomaceous earth in cracks, wipe with vinegar solution
Small Brown Striped Bugs	Brown body, faint stripes	Crawls or jumps	Rarely	Kitchen, pantry, balcony	Store food in sealed containers, clean surfaces	Use sticky traps in pantry, keep fruits/vegetables sealed
Tiny Black Jumping Spider	Small, black, some marking s	Jumps when disturbed, hunts tiny insects	Possible bite, mild irritation	Windows, corners, behind furniture	Capture with jar or vacuum, release outdoors	Use a small cup to trap and release outside, keep corners dry
Fleas	Tiny black, wingless, jumps	Bites humans and pets	Highly	Pets, carpets, bedding	Treat pets, vacuum, wash bedding	Wash pet bedding weekly, sprinkle salt on carpets before vacuuming

Mite s	Tiny, almost invisible, black or brown	Infests bedding or plants	Moder ately	Beds, potted soil	Wash bedding, use mild insecticidal spray	Steam-clean mattresses, spray plants with insecticidal soap
Black Bug	Similar to beetle,	Crawls, attracts to light	Lo w	Windows, doors, furniture	Clean, seal cracks, natural repellents	Use citrus spray or vinegar wipes near doors/windows
Yellow Stripes Back	elongated
